On behalf of Korea University, we are happy to inform you and your students about the 2017 Korea University International Winter Campus (KU IWC) program!

The Korea University International Winter Campus (KU IWC) is a five week academic program which is divided into two separate sessions: **Session 1** (3 weeks) and **Session 2** (2 weeks). Each student can take either one or both sessions; he/she can take up to two courses for Session 1. Session 2 is a culture track (not-for-credit) which offers exclusive one-day seminars, global corporate visits, and various cultural excursions.

More than 20 course offerings cover a wide range of subjects pertaining to international issues, with a particular emphasis on Business, Economics, Humanities, Science, Korean Studies and Korean Language. Along with the academic opportunities, the KU IWC provides chances to experience Korean culture outside of the classroom including one-day field trips such as a fun ski trip or K-pop experience.
